## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to provide an overview of pastoral care from two perspectives: 1) the internal perspective of the personality traits, skills, talents, and habits of the individual as they relate to pastoral care, and 2) the external perspective of congregational routines and situations that raise expectations and assumptions of pastoral care.

## COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of this unit, the student will:

1. The student will be able to articulate an entry-level understanding of pastoral care and define distinctive care-giving roles within specific settings.
2. The student will be able to identify the basic characteristics of his or her personality and assess how these bear on the care-giving ministry.
3. The student will be able to define and describe various critical points in family life and individual life for which specific ministries of care and counseling are often needed.
4. The student will be able to distinguish between situations that can be appropriately dealt with by pastoral counseling and those that call for referral for professional help.
