District Conference Worship and Activities

Fifty-nine attended the Pre-Conference Workshop on "Fruit of Discipleship in Shifting Times" presented by Joshua Brockway, Director for Spiritual Formation for the Church of the Brethren.

Conference officially began with the meal on Friday evening, followed by opening worship. Mike Conner (Moderator) introduced the conference theme with a powerful message from 2 Ephesians 2:8-10 and 2 Corinthians 6:1 on "Grace Through Faith." Worship music was provided by the Painesville Praise Team- Dennis & Bobbie Anderson, Leslie Chappel, Carol Wisen, Bill Fike and Mike Conner.

Saturday evening, Joshua Brockway spoke on Ephesians 3:12-21, on the importance of Christ's love and being filled with God's fullness. The service concluded with the consecration of the 2026 conference officers: Cindy Peel Moderator and Paul Bozman, Moderator-elect.

Fellowship opportunities included multiple insight sessions from Joshua Brockway - Spiritual Gifts or Discipleship, Connections Commission- Immigration "To Welcome the Stranger", Northern Ohio Strategic Planning Committee and Andrew Kauffman, Inspiration Hills Camp Director or hanging out at the Peace Auction and display area, an ice cream social from Smith Dairy, and much time for informal conversation. A "roar" of conversation and laughter could be heard throughout the area anytime there was a break in the business session (and sometimes during the business session!) and between events. It was also a beautiful day to eat and hang out in the pavilion outside.

Conference Business Items

It was a full day the delegates worked their way through the business agenda on Saturday at District Conference. In addition to receiving reports from the board, commissions, treasurer, camp, and national representatives, and others, the delegates:

- 1. Approved the 2026 District Budget as recommended by District Board in the amount of \$166,066—\$29,616 less than the 2025 budget.
- 2. Approved the 2026 Inspiration Hills budget as presented in the amount of \$344,914—\$48,633 less than the 2025 budget.
- 3. Approved the motions to finalize the withdrawal from the denomination of the Dupont and Bristolville Church of the Brethren congregations. A litany of blessing forward reminded us that we continue as brothers and sisters in Christ, even as the churches are no longer part of our district. Prayer was offered for the ministries of these churches and of our district as move forward.
- 4. Approved the motion to close the Lake Breeze Church of the Brethren. A time of remembering the legacy of the congregation concluded with prayer.

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. **Ephesians 2:8-10**
