Some Church of the Brethren congregations in the United States have additional International contacts. International placements by Brethren Volunteer Service (BVS) contribute to the work of Global Mission. The Global Food Initiative is also part of Global Mission. Over the past year, GFI responded to requests for assistance from 27 partner organizations in 10 countries in addition to the US.

BURUNDI

Pray for THARS (Trauma Healing and Reconciliation Services) training center. For rebuilding after storms in late 2021. THARS is a longtime partner with the Church of the Brethren and the Global Food Initiative. THARS provides humanitarian relief.

CHINA

Pray for the You'ai (brethren)
Hospital opening the new center for children with autism. This is led by Christian occupational therapist.
Quality care and services for these children are rare in much of China.

DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Pray for the upcoming Annual Conference for the church as people gather for worship and pass a budget. No other business will be addressed. Pray for safety for travel for leaders from Haiti, Spain and the United States, including the Puerto Rico district. Prayers for the rift between many of the ethnic Haitian churches and the wider church.

DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray for the recent passing of Pastor Balongelwa, who led three Brethren congregations.

EQUADOR

Pray for the United and Brethren Foundation's (FBU) ongoing agricultural work that is supported by the Global Food Initiative of the Church of the Brethren. There will also be several members of churches in the US who will be exploring the possibility of planting a church there. The Church of the Brethren had a significant presence in the 1950s-1990s founded by the FBU.

HAITI

Pray for the situation that continues to be difficult with ongoing gang violence and kidnappings. Church and Haiti Medical Project staff have been caught in crossfire of a gang fight. For continued work to rebuild following the earthquake in Saut Mathurine.

HONDURAS

Pray for the unstable political situation following the election. There is a church and a nonprofit, PAG, with Brethren ties to the country. Pray for the PAG leaders Chet and Lizzeth Thomas that they may return to Honduras soon.

INDIA

Pray for the continued health and recovery of the leaders in India from COVID and other illnesses.

NIGERIA

Pray for the ongoing violence against the churches in Nigeria. More churches have been destroyed and church members kidnapped. We praise God for those who were released or escaped.

RWANDA

Pray for Chris and Grace Elliott (father and daughter) who are currently serving in Rwanda through March. Chris is a pastor and farmer. He is helping with farming and visiting churches and projects in Rwanda and surrounding countries. Grace is teaching in the church's nursery school.

SOUTH SUDAN

Pray for the Church of the Brethren country director Athanasus Ungang returns to South Sudan. Despite challenges, the work continues in agriculture, evangelism, trauma healing, and conflict resolution. Due to local tribal disagreements the center will be temporarily relocated with the materials salvaged.

VENEZUELA

Pray for the upcoming Annual Conference of the church. The church in Venezuela is facing the challenge of new leadership following the founder Robert Anzoategui. It is working to improve bylaws. Due to the costs and challenges of holding a conference in Venezuela, the conference will be held in neighboring Columbia. Pray for safety in travel and the time of gathering together.

UGANDA


We are grateful for the recovery of leaders in Uganda from COVID and other illnesses. Pray for continued healing and strength.
