## **Withdrawing Congregations**

Three churches in the Northern Ohio District have entered the process to withdraw from the Church of the Brethren. Mount Pleasant CoB and Zion Hills CoB had their final votes earlier this month. Both were above the 80% majority needed to withdraw. The next 90 days are a time to finalize details according to our District Withdrawal Policy, which addresses property, financial settlement, and a service of blessing. The withdrawal policy can be found on our website here. The County Line CoB will have their final vote on January 31. District Conference delegates will officially finalize the process at District Conference. While withdrawing removes them as part of our district, we continue as brothers and sisters in Christ, seeking first God's Kingdom.

Our District Executive Committee sent out a letter last fall, encouraging congregation to further engage with denominational leadership in a number of ways.
