2021 NORTHERN OHIO DISTRICT CONFERENCE – ONE DAY / DELEGATE ONLY

Our 2021 Northern Ohio District Conference will be held as a one-day, **delegate only** event at the Akron Springfield Church of the Brethren on August 14th. This will allow for social distancing as part of the COVID-19 precautions that will be in place for those that gather. Each congregation is encouraged to send 2 delegates (churches with membership of 200+ should send 3 delegates).

While there will be no insight sessions, display area, or peace auction on site – the day will open and close with worship. Brad Kelley, Moderator, will speak at the opening worship at 9 am and Tom Zuercher will be the speaker for closing worship at 2:30 pm. The worship services and business sessions will be live streamed so that non-delegates can participate in this day.

On-line registration begins April 1st. The registration fee is \$40 which includes all materials, lunch, and snacks through the day. Lodging is available at Comfort Inn and Suites in Hartville by calling (330) 587-4347 and identifying as being part of the Northern Ohio District Church of the Brethren.

How to Report 2020 Congregational Statistics

Denominational forms for reporting your churches information should have arrived. Reporting attendance for 2020 will be a most unusual challenge. The YearBook office is asking congregations to report average attendance before services were disrupted by COVID-19.

We encourage you to please complete your forms when they arrive. This information is helpful to the district as well as the denomination.

Registration Information from the Annual Conference Office

Church of the Brethren Annual Conference is open. The delegate registration fee is \$305 per delegate. Churches up to 200 members should register one delegate, 201-400 members can register two delegates.

Please note: Unique to this year's ONLINE Annual Conference, each delegate MUST HAVE THEIR OWN PERSONAL EMAIL ADDRESS, A COMPUTER OR TABLET, AS WELL AS ADEQUATE WIFI SERVICE IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN CONFERENCE. Please ensure that your selected delegate meets these requirements to participate so that your congregation can be fully represented at Annual Conference.*

One online site will be used for all business, insight sessions, networking groups, concerts, Bible studies and more. A link and password for access to the site will be emailed to each registrant in the days prior to the start of Conference. Training sessions will be provided in the weeks before Conference begins for those wanting to learn how to navigate the site.

Non-Delegate registration will be \$99 and will provide access to all the events listed above. The charge is necessary to help cover all the costs of hosting a virtual event. All five worship services will be available free of charge to all registered and non-registered persons.
