Annual Conference in Cincinnati

"Living God's Love" is the theme for the 2023 Annual Conference to be held on July 4-8, 2023. The moderator for the conference is Tim McElwee.

Register is now open to everyone. The advance delegate registration fee is \$320 each and the advance non-delegate registration fee is \$140 which will close on June 10. Onsite delegate registration in Cincinnati is \$395 and \$175 for non-delegates.

There is also an online option to register as a Virtual Non-Delegate to watch business online, view special events and concerts, and participate in a number of equipping sessions. The fee is same for non-delegates, \$140 before June 10 and \$175 from June 11-June 27.

Pine Lodge Matching Fund Opportunity

The Northern Ohio District has received a wonderful gift from the estate of Darlene Bucher. The District Board, at their March 11th meeting acted on the recommendation from the Stewardship and Finance Commission to use one-half of the \$25,594.79 gift to provide matching funds for donations given to repair Pine Lodge at Inspiration Hills Camp.

Pine Lodge was built 55 years ago and has very little work done since then. The windows need replaced and the woodpeckers have drilled holes into the logs that are the siding for the building. This is a great space for a smaller group sleeping up to 26, but because of the current state (including bats in the ceiling and squirrels, mice, and chipmunks running through the walls) it is difficult to rent out.
