# With Much Gratitude

The Northern Ohio District Board is grateful for the gift of \$25,594.79 received from the estate of Darlene Bucher. Darlene was the wife of Gordon Bucher who served as the District Executive in Northern Ohio for more than 30 years. One-half of the gift will be used to match donations for the repair of Pine Lodge at Inspiration Hills Camp (see below for details). The other half (\$12, 297.39) will be placed in the District's Excellence in Ministry Fund. This fund provides for continuing education programs, events, and retreats for credentialed clergy; scholarships to assist clergy with financial needs to attend events; and for pastor recognition programs and appreciation gifts. For all the years that the Bucher's encouraged pastors in our district, this seemed a fitting use of this special bequest.

# **Matching Fund Opportunity**

The Northern Ohio District has received a wonderful gift from the estate of Darlene Bucher. The District Board, at their March 11<sup>th</sup> meeting acted on the recommendation from the Stewardship and Finance Commission to use one-half of the \$25,594.79 gift to provide matching funds for donations given to repair Pine Lodge at Inspiration Hills Camp.

Pine Lodge was built 55 years ago and has very little work done since then. The windows need replaced and the woodpeckers have drilled holes into the logs that are the siding for the building. This is a great space for a smaller group sleeping up to 26, but because of the current state (including bats in the ceiling and squirrels, mice, and chipmunks running through the walls) it is difficult to rent out.

The repairs are estimated at \$40,000. The district board would like to help get a jump start on donations for this project by matching the first \$12,297.40 that comes in. So each dollar donation will bring \$2 to the project, \$100 will bring \$200, \$1,000 will bring \$2,000 to the project. Checks should be written to "Northern Ohio District Church of the Brethren" with the memo of "Pine Lodge" and mailed to the District Office at 1107 East Main Street, Ashland, OH 44805. We will then match the donation and send it along to the camp.



Greetings! We have news to share from the Brethren Disaster Ministries (BDM) District Coordinator team!

Northern Ohio is on the

schedule to volunteer in Dawson Creek, Kentucky, May 21-27, and Sept. 3-9. A little over a year ago, the area was hit by tornadoes and according to the denomination's BDM website — "estimates are that around 75 percent of the town of Dawson Springs was leveled, which was home to around 2,500 people. Over 650 of the 1,200 housing units in the town were lost and there were 15 lives that were lost." BDM is working with Habitat for Humanity to build new homes. (Please go to the Brethren Disaster Ministries website for more information).

We are excited about this opportunity and are hoping to hear from many of you who might be able to go along. We have committed to bring 7 people each week, ages 15 and up, who have "a deep desire to share the love of Christ by helping others". (A waiting list will be joyfully started if needed.) There is no expectation that volunteers are skilled tradesmen; only that they have a willingness to work, learn, cooperate, listen, and share God's love. We plan to rent a van and travel to Kentucky together for both weeks. We will leave the morning of Sunday, May 21 (Sunday, Sept. 3) and return the evening of May 27 (Sept.9). All costs – food, travel and housing will be covered.

We would also like to invite you to participate in the Inspiration Hills Camp Annual Work Weekend, beginning Friday, April 28<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 am and ending Saturday, the 29<sup>th</sup> at 3:00. Overnight lodging and food will be provided. This time would be a great opportunity to meet and work with some who are going to Kentucky and those who like to serve but cannot go on the trips. It will be a good time to work together, maybe learn a new skill, help the camp, and have an experience similar to volunteering with BDM.

We are excited to work together with you as our District continues to be involved in serving others through Brethren Disaster Ministries. Please call or email any of us on the district disaster coordinator team with questions, suggestions, and/or a commitment to serve.
