The eruption, which started on September 19, was not declared over until Christmas Day. People returning have a major cleanup job ahead. Ash is piled everywhere in places, deep enough to cover houses. People still risk further eruptions, toxic gas (possibly trapped in basements), & acid rain. La Palma is one of the Spanish Canary Islands off the coast of Africa.
- **Madagascar** Nearly a month's worth of rain fell in 48 hours in some areas causing major flooding. At least 10 have died & 12,000 have been left homeless.
- Haiti 2 earthquakes hit the island on Monday. 2 people have died & 50 have been injured. 190 homes were destroyed & 590 damaged, leaving 834 families homeless.
