

It was announced today, that the current president was reelected, however, the second-place candidate has not conceded citing irregularities in the election process. The elections were originally scheduled for Feb. 16, but were postponed hours before polls were to open. Anger and frustration are high among political parties, businesses, and individuals. Voter turnout was lower than expected. Many Nigerians must travel long distances to their polling places and may not have been able to make a second trip. It also appears that some voters were kept away from the poles by intimidation and violence. Many schools and businesses were closed due to security concerns.
