

COURSE DESCRIPTION

To develop an overview of the background, structure and purpose of the books of the New Testament with the goal of applying its concepts to the practical tasks of pastoral ministry in the Church of the Brethren.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of this unit, the student will:

- A. Be able to identify each of the books of the NT in terms of their literary genre, origin in the life of the early church & basic issues or themes.
- B. Be able to describe the formation of the NT canon & its authority for the church's faith & life.
- C. Be able to identify some of the basic features of Jesus' ministry & message & compare the different portraits of Jesus in the 4 gospels.
- D. Be able to place at least 24 key figures & events on a timeline of the era of the Christian origins.
- E. Be able to take a selected text from the NT & demonstrate its use as a resource for a particular area of ministry.
